William C. Eacho III. is the U.S. Ambassador to Austria. Before that, he was a successful business manager and entrepreneur with a history of active civic engagement. Mr. Eacho received a Master's degree in Business Administration with Distinction from Harvard Business School in 1979. Prior to attending Harvard, he was a Financial Analyst in the Corporate Finance department of Hornblower & Weeks, Hemphill-Noyes, Inc., in New York and in Los Angeles. He graduated Magna Cum Laude from Duke University in Durham, North Carolina, where he majored in Law and the Economy.



Hans Dietmar Schweisgut, born in Tyrol, graduated from the Law Faculty of Innsbruck University. Following post-graduate studies at SMU (Dallas) and the Diplomatic Academy in Vienna he joined the foreign service. After having been posted to Austria's UN-Mission in New York and to Tokyo he became Director General at the Ministry of Finance. He served as Ambassador to Japan and China, before his current position as Permanent Representative to the E.U.
